We are convinced that the action of reading needs to combine reading with the image contemplation, this is why each book we develop has an album format.



TOSHIO HIRAOKA

Toshio Hiraoka es especialista en la construcción de casas que caben en la palma de una mano y maestro de Irina Popov (inventora de habitaciones para albergar el vacío.) Su día comienza a las cinco de la mañana con la lectura de una página del Ensayo acerca de la construcción de jardines de Tachibana Toshitsuna y sigue con una caminata que tiene por objetivo la recolección de materiales.

"Las vetas de las paredes, para las que uso madera o piedra, representan los paisajes que recorro, siguiendo los principios del shakkei o escenario prestado. En la disposición de las habitaciones no busco seguir un orden, sino el requerimiento original de la roca y la madera. Se trata de comprender los puntos interesantes de los paisajes donde esos materiales fueron encontrados y luego, recrear las escenas de manera interpretativa, no estricta".

Irina Popov lo escucha y toma apuntes en su libreta, haciendo sus propias interpretaciones: "las casas del maestro Hiraoka son un microcosmos. Piedras y trozos de madera que nos hablan de la forma en que los paisajes de la mente reflejan la realidad (hay espacios –habitaciones vacías, habitaciones que imitan hojas de cedro – en los que esa realidad se contorsiona)".

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
Fantastic Anatomy Encyclopedia


Pedro Mañas Mariana Alcántara




Mask




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Sidelines




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Howling




ADOLFO CÓRDOVA




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
Panther


They also invite to read and discover in a tactile and playful way. With text in Braille for blind or partially sighted readers.














MARÍA JOSÉ FERRADA






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Children







