

Davide Calì - Marianna Balducci The big-nosed princess

Once upon a time there was a little princess with flowing red hair and lovely freckles: she was pretty, graceful and because of her irresistible graces everyone loved her. But alas, growth spares no one: someone gets extra-long feet, someone else ends up with extra inches of height ... and our princess one morning, as soon as she woke up, realized that her pretty little nose had turned into a huge, unmanageable, uncontrollable nose. A nose that seems to live a life of its own, at least a growth of its own, and which neither hints at going away nor diminishing. The numerous suitors vanish, and the princess seems doomed to unhappiness--but is this really so? Is it possible that a princess as beautiful and intelligent as she is should be discouraged by the scorn of a few foolish courtiers? Rebelling against social pressures and dusty aesthetic canons, the big-nosed princess takes her destiny into her own hands and becomes queen, building for herself not one but six hilarious endings.


NICOLETTA ASNICAR




DAVIDE CALÌ








Mathilde Tourbillon - Luigi Berio *Johnny and the hidden treasure*






Elena Levi




Elena Levi Mathilde Tourbillon
